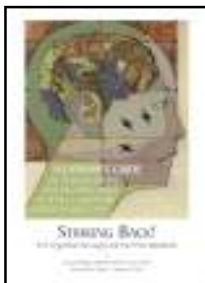

By Rail
Nearest station: Kings Cross
London Euston, Kings Cross and St Pancras International stations are under a thirty minute walk from the venue or a short taxi ride. Kings Cross station is just three stops away on the London Underground's Piccadilly line.

All of London's remaining mainline stations, including London Victoria, Paddington and Waterloo are easily reached by the Underground network.

By London Underground
Nearest Underground station: Convent Garden
Convent Garden Underground station (Piccadilly line) is a short walk from the hotel. The Piccadilly line connects Kings Cross station with London Heathrow Airport. Heathrow airport is approximately 40 minutes by tube from Covent Garden.

By Air
Nearest airport: London Heathrow International
London Heathrow International airport is 18 miles away. All of London's international and domestic airports have excellent links into central London.

The nearest car park is on the corner of Drury Lane and Parker Street and is only a two minute stroll.

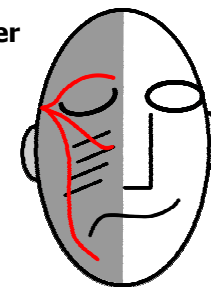
